AIMS AND TOPIC OF THE CONFERENCE

PAPERS AND POSTERS

The length of paper is 15 minutes. Data and overhead projectors are available. Posters will be presented in the form of panel discussion. Maximum poster dimensions: 75×120 cm (width x height). In case of high number of registered papers, the scientific committee reserves the right to reclassify some papers into poster presentations.

Abstracts of papers and posters will be published in the Aragonit journal vol. 18, no. 1, which will the participants receive at the conference registration. Extended abstracts of 1500 and 3000 characters (without figures and map attachments) shall be posted by July 15, 2013 to address: bella@ssj.sk. Abstracts can be in Slovak, Czech or English language. Where appropriate, it is possible to state the list of references cited in the text at the end of abstract, the authors should have their workplace with complete address.

Original scientific papers from the conference will be reviewed and published in the karstological and speleological journals Slovak Karst and Aragonit in 2013 and 2014. Guidelines for authors will be issued in the 2nd circular.

CONFERENCE FEE

The conference fee of 50 EUR, payable at the registration, includes organizational costs, rent of conference room, refreshment during breaks, print of abstracts in the Aragonit journal and conference papers submitted into the journals Slovak Karst and Aragonit.
